Getaway Modern Cabins

Nothing screams relaxation quite like roasting marshmallows outside your cozy forest cabin. <u>Getaway</u> <u>Modern Cabins</u> in the Catskills is about two hours away from the city and starts at \$169 a night for up to four people. Each cabin includes a shower, a fire pit, and a kitchen.

Hershey Park

If you're looking for something the whole family can enjoy on the extended Martin Luther King holiday weekend, Hershey Park is a great choice! Tickets start at \$76 for a one-day pass, or \$56 for a two-day pass, and include access to the amusement park, the zoo, Hershey's Chocolatetown, and more, family

Tarrytown House Estate

Tarrytown House Estate is a short, 45-minute drive from New York City. This cozy, 1800s-inspired estate sits on 26 acres of land along the Hudson River. Enjoy on-site fine dining, swimming, and sports facilities as you stay in this sanctuary, starting at \$142 a night.

The spa-hotel features 27 treatment rooms, a sauna, a salon, a gym, multiple restaurants, an indoor pool, and more than 40 acres of land to explore. Their Winter Special runs through the end of February with spa treatments starting at \$50 and rooms for \$175 a night.
