Pride Month | June

Some highlights include the <u>free Pride Family Picnic</u> at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine on June 23, <u>free queer history walking tours</u> every weekend at The Whitney Museum, the <u>outdoor Ladyland festival in Brooklyn</u>, and the <u>Pride March</u> in Manhattan on June 30.

Flag Day | June 14

The Fraunces Tavern Museum, which aims to preserve the history of the American Revolution in Manhattan's Financial District, will host a <u>Flag Day Parade and Open House</u> beginning at 12:00 p.m. to commemorate the adoption of the U.S. flag in 1777.

Summer Solstice | June 20

Celebrate the longest day of the year at <u>Socrates Sculpture</u> <u>Park</u> in Queens with free workshops and live music from 4:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., or visit the free <u>Swedish Midsummer Festival</u> at Rockefeller Park in Manhattan on June 21 for a Swedish food court, flower crown-making activities, and lawn games for kids from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

National Take Your Dog to Work Day | June 21

After a "ruff" day at the office, head to a "people-friendly dog cafe" like the <u>Château le Woof</u> in Astoria or <u>Boris & Horton</u> in the East Village and Williamsburg. Then, get your tickets to the <u>Barking Dog</u> Restaurant's <u>Paint and Sip Pet Portrait event</u> to paint your pup from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on the Upper East Side.

Global Beatles Day | June 25

Visit the <u>Brooklyn Museum</u> in Prospect Heights for a new photo exhibition, <u>Paul McCartney Photographs</u> <u>1963-1964: Eyes of the Storm</u>, which runs until August 18 and showcases images taken by McCartney during the Beatles' first U.S. tour. Entry to the exhibit is included with a general admission ticket.

Social Media Day I June 30

For the perfect post, stop by one of the city's new, colorful museums designed with selfies in mind: Mercer Labs in the Financial District, the Museum of Illusions in the West Village, and Sloomoo Institute in SoHo.
