Boo at the Zoo

Family-friendly Halloween festivities are included with admission at the <u>Bronx Zoo</u> now through October 27. Activities include a Halloween maze, face painting, costume parades, and magic shows. Zoo tickets start at \$38 for adults and \$28 for children.

Candlelight Concerts

Enjoy an unforgettable evening with <u>Candlelight Concerts</u>, a global event series that brings classical performance to unconventional locations. The event returns to <u>Brooklyn</u> on October 19 and to <u>Manhattan</u> on October 24 and 25. Tickets start at \$40.

Rooftop Cinema Club

Every day in October, the <u>Rooftop Cinema Club</u> will host spooky movie showings at the Embassy Suites Hotel rooftop in Midtown Manhattan. Screenings after 7:00 p.m. are reserved for adults and tickets start at \$24.

Pumpkin Blaze

Wander through <u>The Great Jack O' Lantern Blaze</u>, where you'll find more than 7,000 hand-carved pumpkins illuminated in a synchronized light show. Located in Long Island, the family-friendly, 45-minute experience is open now through November 3. Timed tickets start at \$39 for adults and \$10 for children.

Snug Harbor Séances

Visit the <u>Snug Harbor Cultural Center</u> to learn about the history of séances and the tools used to contact spirits. The outdoor events are hosted weekly on Friday and Saturday nights in October. Tickets are \$15.

Madame Morbid

Learn about the borough's haunted history in a 90-minute trip and enjoy spooky trivia games throughout your ride. Tours happen twice per night, Wednesday through Sunday, every week in October. Tickets are \$69.
