Team up with friends at <u>Beat the Bomb</u> in Brooklyn, an immersive experience combining escape room puzzles with high-tech challenges. Work together to dodge lasers, crack codes, and disarm a "bomb" before it explodes with slime, paint, or foam! Each experience lasts one hour and requires at least four players. Tickets are \$40 per person.

Five Iron brings you high-tech golf simulators with a casual atmosphere and a full menu of food and drinks at six locations across Manhattan and Brooklyn. Simulator reservations are \$70 per hour for up to six guests and golf clubs are provided at no additional cost. Advance reservation is recommended.

Go-Kart Racing

Put the pedal to the metal at <u>RPM Raceway</u>, a new high-speed go-kart arena with locations in Jersey City, Farmingdale, and Stamford. Tickets start at \$30 per person per race. Children must be at least eight years old and 48" tall to race in the Junior class.

Area53

Area53 is a family entertainment center in Williamsburg offering an arcade, obstacle course, rock climbing wall, paintball arena, and skating rink. They also host weekly Adult Nights on Thursdays at 9:00 p.m. featuring a live DJ. Tickets start at \$42 per person.

Classic Arcades

Rediscover NYC's arcades for a mix of nostalgia and fun. <u>Barcade</u>, a bar/arcade combo, has multiple locations in Manhattan and Brooklyn with over 70 classic arcade and pinball games. For family-friendly arcades, try <u>Laser Bounce</u> in Queens and <u>Chinatown Fair Arcade</u>.

Bowling Alleys

Brooklyn Bowl in Williamsburg doubles as a live music venue, while <u>The Gutter</u>, with locations in Manhattan, Brooklyn, and Queens, is a bowling alley/bar combo with vintage lanes. <u>Bowlero's</u> family-friendly locations in Manhattan and Queens offer bowling, arcade games, and a full menu of food and drinks.
